Turnitin is a 'text-matching' software which is designed to provide confidence in the academic integrity of faculty, research scholars, and students work. Turnitin does this by comparing the submissions against an archive of Internet documents, Internet data, a repository of previously submitted papers, and subscription repository of periodicals, journals, and publications Turnitin then creates an 'Originality Report' which can be viewed by faculty, research scholars and students, which identifies where the submitted text has matched another source.

Turnitin has been working hard on its Al writing (such as ChatGPT) detector. According to the creators, an Al writing indicator will be added to Turnitin's Similarity Report to show the likelihood that the document was Al-generated.
